

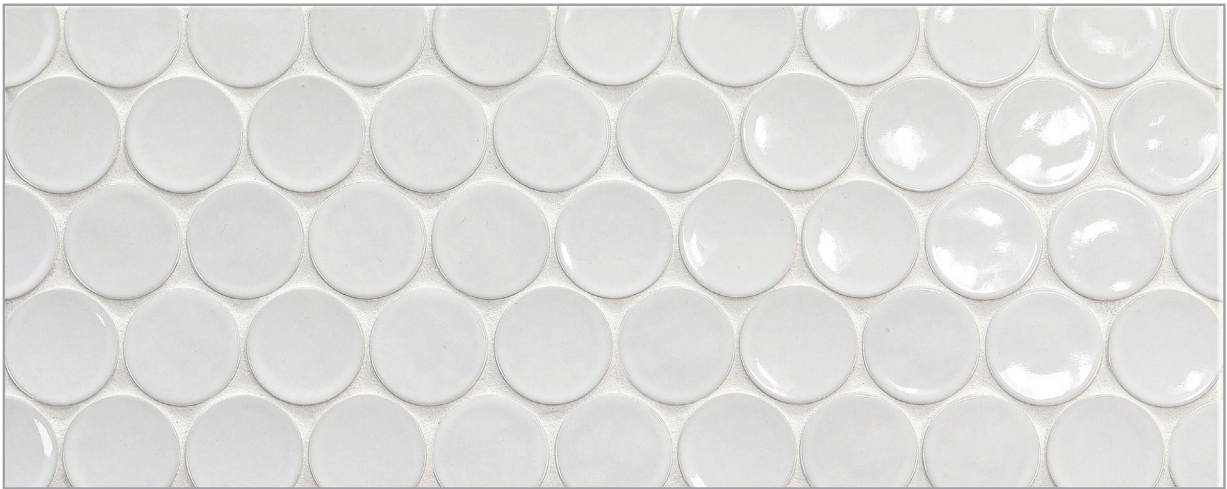

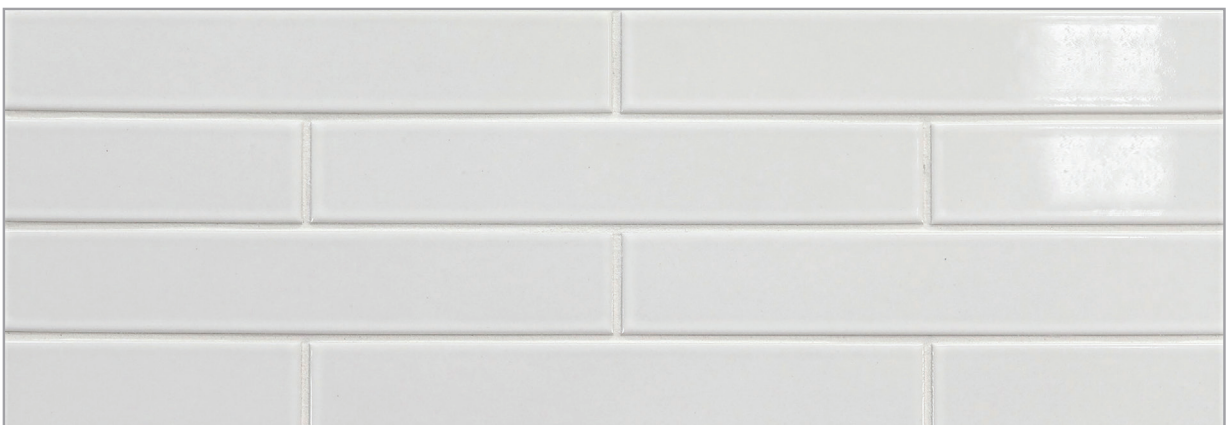

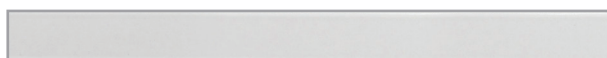
Buoy Mosaic (2")

Plank (1  $\frac{5}{8}$  x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ )

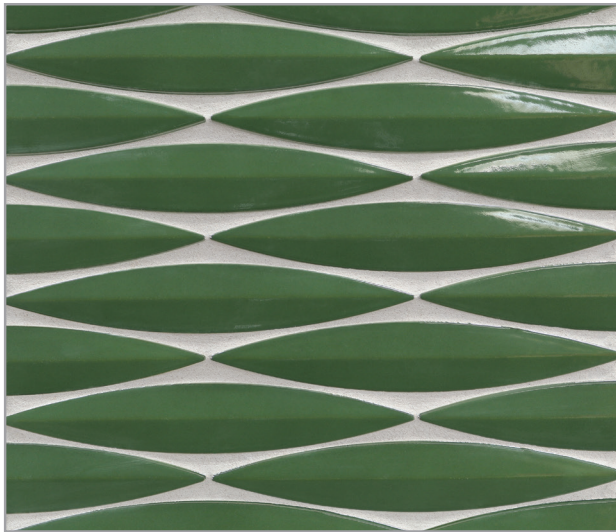


Liner ( $\frac{3}{4}$  x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ )

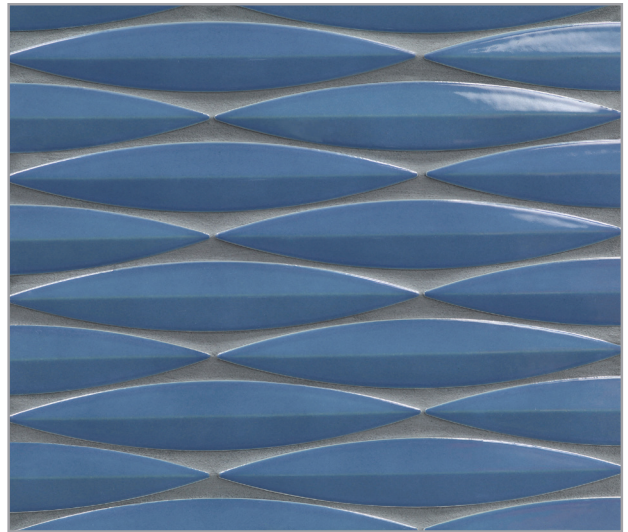
For more design options, Liners are also glazed on 3 sides.



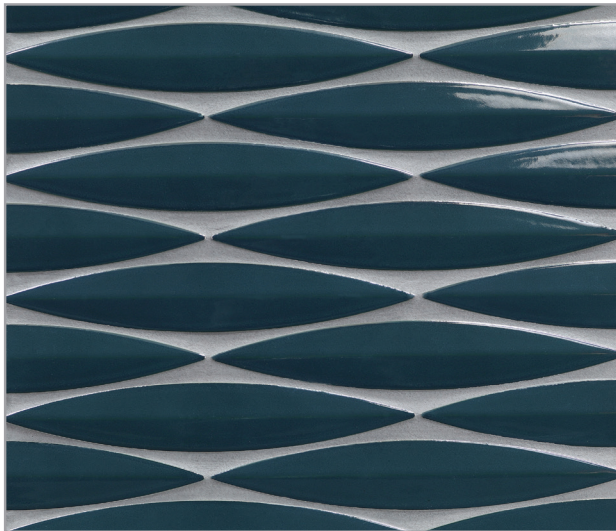
